## WEEKEND CAMP KIT LIST

This list contains items that Scouts should bring on a weekend camp. If you have any questions don't hesitate to ask any leader.

**All items should be clearly marked with the Scout's name.**

Ideally everything should be packed in a single rucksack or large waterproof bag (e.g. a Bergen). Scouts may have to carry their kit from the drop-off point to the camp. Suitcases are not suitable for Scout camp.

### CLOTHING

Unless otherwise stated, Scouts should arrive at camp in uniform and leave in uniform. They should wear their Scout Shirt and necker, with trousers and footwear appropriate to the activity.

Waterproof coat/cagoul  
Change of trousers  
Change of jumper/fleece  
Spare T-shirt  
Spare socks and underwear  
Stout walking boots  
Old trainers  
In Winter – woolly hat, scarf and gloves  
In Summer – camp shorts and sun hat

### EQUIPMENT

Washing kit and towel  
Plate & bowl or mess tins  
Knife, fork and spoon  
Unbreakable Mug  
Drinks bottle  
Personal First Aid Kit  
Torch and spare batteries  
Metal Coat hanger (for uniform)  
Large polythene bag (for wet clothes, etc.)  
A small supply of sweets/chocolate can be brought but avoid fizzy drinks.

### BEDDING

Sleeping Bag – in Winter a spare blanket can be helpful  
Karrimat/sleeping roll  
There is no need to bring a pillow – if a Scout prefers to raise their head when sleeping, bring an empty pillowcase that can be filled with a coat/towel/spare clothes at night.

### MEDICATION

Any medication should be clearly marked with the person's name and details of the dosage. Please ensure a Scout Leader is informed and is clear whether it will be carried by the Scout or kept by the leaders for use in an emergency.

### TECHNOLOGY & MONEY

Normally phones, tablets, cameras, etc. are **not needed at camp** and can be the source of problems if they are lost or damaged.

Money is not normally required for weekend camps – if it is needed this will be clearly stated in the instructions for the event. In these cases leaders will operate a camp bank.
